

Choshen - Breastplate - חושן

One (1) Donor Opportunity at \$18,000, representing the Breast Plate worn by the High Priests in Temple Times, encrusted with 12 precious stones, each representing a tribe.



A Plaque to honor all donors, to include the names of those honored and memorialized, will be developed; displayed in the synagogue, separate from the niche design.

This Niche Beautification Project incorporates stained glass medallions, depicting the 12 Tribes of Israel.

The 12 Tribes of Israel, as depicted in the 10" round medallions, were taken from the original Adath Israel Synagogue Building, built in the early years of the 1920s.
