High Holiday services are an important part of our children's Jewish education. Services are being prepared so that each age group will have a meaningful experience. *Zayin* (7<sup>th</sup> grade) students will join the congregation in the sanctuary.

**On** *Rosh HaShanah, September 16 and 17, 2023*, children's services will begin at 11:15 a.m. and conclude at 12:45 p.m. Please note that the *Tashlich* service will take place by the creek immediately following the conclusion of the services on the second day of *Rosh Hashanah*.

**On Yom Kippur, September 25, 2023**, services will begin at 11:45 a.m. and conclude at 1:30 p.m. To accommodate families who will remain for *Yizkor*, extended supervision will be available. <u>Parents must</u> register their children in advance so that we can provide adequate supervision. We encourage all families and students to come back for *Neilah* Services at 6:15 p.m.; please bring shofars, spice boxes, and flashlights.

We encourage and welcome every child to actively participate in an age-appropriate service. In the unlikely event of unreasonable or inappropriate behavior, a child will be escorted back to his/her parents. If you have a child with special needs, a parent or designated adult should plan to remain with him/her.
